It's almost impossible to tell where the original portion of the 1950's farmhouse-style home was and where the addition comes in. The design of the addition enhances the home yet reflects the modern-day uses.

The original plans called for two ceiling collar ties made of three 2x8's and wrapped with pine. Thomas Wolfe decided to take it another step and surprised the homeowner's with custom-made 6x8 timbers milled locally. They then mortised the beams for tenons and pegs to give the room an old world charm feeling.



The beamwork, hardwood floors, molding, and the wood burning stove on the one wall, reflect an earlier time.



The room is designed to exceed the customers desires and to retain the charm of the original home.
